
Lib Dems back plan to tackle town traffic

'No' to merger with Soton

Residents have expressed anger that a group of Hampshire Conservative MPs, including Mims Davies, have challenged the Borough's Local Plan that seeks to protect countryside gaps between our towns and villages, and also to prevent merger with Southampton.

The MPs wrote to the Council favouring a scheme to make Eastleigh an urban sprawl from Millbrook to Fair Oak, forcing more traffic along Allington Lane, Fair Oak and Bishopstoke Roads. The MPs' plan would come with no infra-





structure improvements to tackle traffic.

MISSING: the Chickenhall Lane Link Road that we were promised would be funded within 100 days of the 2015 election.

MISSING: "Junction 6" on the M27 - which Highways England <u>refuses</u> to consider.

MISSING: better rail links with NO additional rail station.

The Lib Dems are having none of this. We live here and care about our area and don't want even more traffic forced through busy roads.

The Lib Dem Local Plan takes traffic away from Fair Oak and Bishopstoke Roads with a new link to Junction 12 of the M3.
